## Work Platform Decking & Netting Systems

### Course Outline

#### BASIC INSTALLER

##### Overview

This three day course is designed to instruct personnel in the specific systems, requirements and techniques for competently installing, maintaining and the safe use of the WEB Platform Decking (WPD) and Netting (WPN) systems.

This can be done at one of the WEB Rigging Services purpose-designed training facilities or a suitable client facility.

The course is aimed at all personnel that will be involved in the installation and usage of these systems when using either normal working at height practices in accordance with Working at Height Regulations 2005 (or national equivalent), or rope access techniques in accordance with national requirements.

Any candidates carrying out using rope access techniques must hold current qualifications in accordance with national requirements.

Although no rigging experience is necessary it would be beneficial for offshore works if candidates held OPITO, EMTA Level 2 rigging qualifications or equivalent.

On completion of a final practical assessment and final written paper the successful candidate will be issued with a WEB Rigging Services Certificate of Competence – Basic Installer, which should be refreshed after three years.

##### Course Content and Structure

###### Day 1: Introduction to the WPD & WPN Systems

- Review of Working at Height Regulations 2005 and PPE requirements and checks

- Review of LOLER 1998 Regulations with regards to WPN & WPD and associated rigging equipment

- Planning and Risk Assessment for the installation and use of the WPN & WPD systems

- Introduction to rigging equipment and equipment safety check requirements

###### Day 2: Practical installation and usage of WPN & WPD systems

- Practical and written assessment
